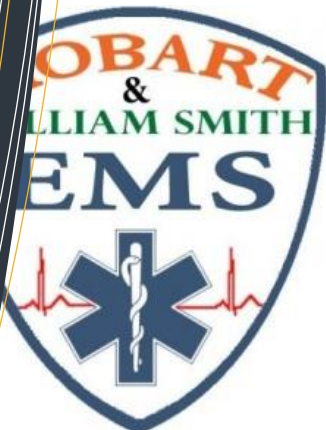
## EMT-BASIC COURSE

Every spring semester, Hobart & William Smith Emergency Medical Service facilitates an EMT-Basic course in conjunction with the Finger Lakes Regional EMS Council and Finger Lakes Community College.

Non-certified students accepted to HWS EMS are eligible to take our affiliated course free of charge (textbook fee not covered).

The 120 plus hour course is held within walking distance from the HWS campus, and is comprised of both lecture-dense and practical skill-based classes. Students enrolled in the course must also complete a rigorous clinical-rotation with several local ambulance services. Students who successfully complete the course are eligible candidates for the New York State EMT-Basic examination process.

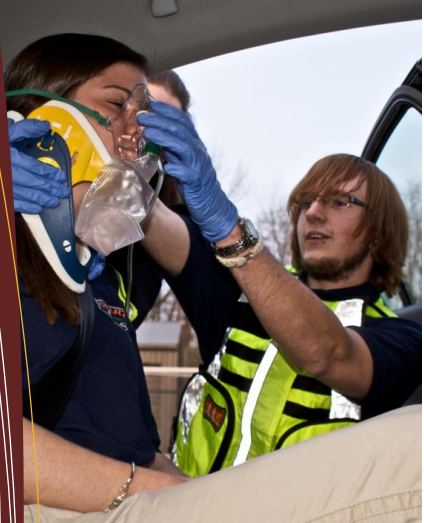

## Responding to emergencies 24/7

### RAPID RESPONSE (NON-TRANSPORTING) EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE

During the academic year, Hobart & William Smith Emergency Medical Service is responsible for responding to all medical emergencies on the Geneva campus. Additionally, HWS EMS provides on-site standby coverage for athletic events, concerts, and other collegiate activities. It operates as an entirely volunteer, non-charging, non-paid, student run medical service.

Our membership currently consists of about 15 responders, though we are looking to expand our numbers. Additionally, training is supplemented with monthly practical skill sessions and lectures. All active members are currently New York State certified Emergency Medical Technicians, in addition to various other specialized qualifications.

### MEMBERSHIP

The membership structure of the Hobart & William Smith Emergency Medical Service is designed to ensure that the HWS community receives the highest quality BLS care from appropriately certified, trained, and mannered student responders.

### CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP

The following criteria must be met for an individual to be a member of HWS EMS:

1. Be a student member of the Hobart & William Smith community
2. Cannot be in their senior year when applying unless approved by the Captain
3. Must be in good standing (academically and socially) with the Colleges
4. Must be at least 18 years old
5. Provide Identification (Driver's License, Passport, State ID. etc)

The additional following criteria must be met for an individual to be an active member:

7. Maintain a current NYS certification as an EMT-B or higher
8. Maintain a current AHA certification in BLS CPR
