**Trustee Scholarship for Academic Excellence: First-Year Applicants 2009-2010****Deadline January 1**

Hobart and William Smith Colleges encourage students with excellent academic records to apply for the Trustee Scholarship for Academic Excellence, which awards \$20,000 per year to the winners. In order to **apply**, you must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- a cumulative average of 90 or the equivalent
- rank in the top 10 percent of your class
- SAT scores of 1250 (combined critical reading and math only) or higher or an ACT Composite of 28 or higher

In addition, you must send this application, along with all admissions application materials, to the Office of Admissions no later than **January 1**. All Trustee Scholar applicants must have a personal interview either with an admissions representative or an alumni/alumnae representative no later than **January 19** in order to be considered for the scholarship. Appointments for interviews must be made by **January 8**. **Please note: Applicants who wish to be considered for the Trustee Scholarship must submit standardized test scores (SAT or ACT).**

Only 50-60 Trustee Scholars are awarded each year — roughly 10% of those students who apply. Trustee Scholars winners will be notified in early February and invited to a recognition day on **February 27**. The winners of the full-tuition Hersh and Wood Scholarships will be selected from this group. Those not selected for the Trustee Scholarship can still be considered for other scholarships, including the Faculty, Arts and Presidential Leaders and Service scholarships.
