# **HWS Non-Matriculated Students**

#### What Is A Non-Matriculated Student?

Students admitted to Hobart and William Smith Colleges on a non-matriculating or "visiting" basis are not actively working towards completion of an undergraduate degree or enrolled in a degree program at HWS.

#### As a Non-Matriculated Student, How Do I Register For Courses?

Step 1: Students wishing to be considered for non-matriculating status must complete and submit the Non-Matriculated Student Application Form available on the following site-→ <a href="http://www.hws.edu/offices/forms.aspx">http://www.hws.edu/offices/forms.aspx</a>
Do ONE of the following:

- 1.) Mail the form to the respective Dean of the College, Hobart and William Smith Colleges, Smith Hall, Geneva, NY 14456
- 2.) Students in the Foreign Language Teacher/Scholars Program or the NY6 Consortium: Bring the completed form to the Associate Provost, second floor, Coxe Hall.

## Who May Apply for a Non-Matriculated Undergraduate Enrollment?

- Students who are currently enrolled in high school and wish to take a college level course
- Students who are enrolled in the HWS Graduate Attendee Program and who are five or more years beyond graduation
- Students enrolled as Foreign Language Teacher/Scholars
- Students enrolled in the HWS Educational Second Chances Program
- Students enrolled through the Rochester Area Colleges Consortium
- HWS employee or spouse/dependent son or daughter of employee (consult with Office of Human Resources for tuition and fees)
- Students who have graduated from high school and are or have been matriculated at another college or university and wish to take courses to transfer to their home institution
- Adults who wish to take courses for personal enrichment or career advancement but are not seeking a degree at HWS

**Step 2:** Register for Classes - We strongly recommend that you discuss your plans with the appropriate Dean of the College (or with the Associate Provost for students in the Foreign Language Teacher/Scholar Program) before taking any classes.

Non-matriculated students register for classes on a space-available basis and require the written permission of the instructor of the course. HWS reserves the right to deny entry to a class if a non-matriculated student does not meet the prerequisite or other established registration criteria.

# PRIVACY NOTICE FOR EU STUDENTS AND REQUEST FOR CONSENT FOR PROCESSING

Pursuant to the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (the "GDPR"), this notice is to provide you with information about the processing of the personal data of students like you by Hobart and William Smith Colleges (the "HWS"). HWS collects personal data about students in a variety of ways and for a variety of reasons. For example, we may collect personal data from you when you register for classes or apply for financial aid. In each case, HWS's use of personal data will comply with the provisions of this Notice.

- 1. The Data Controller is HWS. You may contact the colleges with any questions about this Notice by contacting Peter Sarratori at sarratori@hws.edu.
- 2. All personal data will be processed exclusively for HWS's legitimate interests connected or related to providing education, financial aid, housing and related services to each student that provides personal data. In some cases, we may process personal data you provide to fulfill our contractual obligations to you, for example if you purchase books or event tickets from HWS. We may also process student personal data to fulfill our obligations established by applicable law and regulation.
- 3. Personal data may include special categories of personal data, such as personal data revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, genetic data, biometric data, data concerning health, or the person's gender identification. HWS will process special categories of personal data only with your explicit consent for the following purposes: in connection with the provision of primary or ancillary educational services, to provide student health services, financial aid packaging and services, athletic participation (including sports medicine services), club and miscellaneous student activities participation, volunteer opportunities and co-curricular opportunities including but not limited to study abroad opportunities, career services activities, or community engagement activities, course registration, and required reporting to clearinghouses or to comply with any and all legal requirements.
- 4. Your personal data will be handled by employees, contractors and agents of HWS that are responsible for activities related to the purposes specified above. HWS may also provide your personal data to its service providers performing services on our behalf relating to the specified purposes, such as our hosting service providers, and to public or private entities as may be necessary to respond to a subpoena, regulation, binding order of a data protection agency, legal process, governmental request or other legal or regulatory process, and to enforce our rights or protect our property.
- 5. The personal data you have provided may be transferred to the United States of America pursuant to the terms, conditions and limits specified by Chapter V of the GDPR.
- 6. HWS will store your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the original purpose for which it was provided and to meet its legal and regulatory obligations, and in compliance with HWS's document retention policy.
- 7. You have the right under the GDPR to request from HWS access, rectification and erasure of your personal data, to request a copy of your personal data, to request that HWS restrict the processing of your personal data and to object to the processing of your personal data.
- 8. You can withdraw your consent to the processing of special categories of personal data, the processing of which by HWS is based on your explicit consent, at any time by contacting Peter Sarratori at sarratori@hws.edu, but this will not affect the lawfulness of processing your personal data based on your consent before withdrawal. If you withdraw your consent, we may not be able to provide certain services to you.
