

Students who are interested in living in Emerson or suites/quads in Caird, deCordova, Hale, or Durfee are asked to complete the application and return it to the Office of Residential Education by 5:00pm on Wednesday, April 8th.

Housing in Emerson suites is limited to students in good academic and social standing. All-senior suites will be filled prior to senior-mixed suites, all junior before junior mixed, and any remaining suites available to all-sophomore groups. There are eleven six-person suites available in Emerson. Caird and deCordova each have one two-person suite (male in Caird, female in deCordova) and a **total** of five 4-person suites for each gender between the two buildings. Hale and Durfee have a limited number of four-person suites for men. **Please be prepared to form four-person groups or participate in another selection process if you are unable to select a suite in Emerson.**

Each group will use the lowest lottery number of the individuals on each application to select a specific suite. **Only one representative from each unit is needed to attend the Suite Lottery on Thursday, April 9th (6:00pm seniors only; 6:15pm seniors and juniors mixed; 7:00 juniors only; 8:00 juniors/mixed; 8:30 sophomores) in the Vandervort Room.**
